But the mission didn't stop there! As Service Chair, Rebecca continued on to Texas Children's Hospital (TCH) North Austin, a new but vital facility already making a big impact.

Though TCH North Austin is less than a year old, it's serving pediatric cancer patients from all over Central Texas—San Antonio to Temple, Waco to Bryan-College Station. With 72% of their young warriors under the age of 10, the hospital is providing much-needed care closer to home, eliminating long trips to Houston. While we couldn't interact directly with patients due to health precautions, we had a great conversation with Medical Director Dr. Morad, who was thrilled about the possibility of future partnerships with the Lions.

Most importantly, this effort was a reminder that no child fights alone. Our service let these brave kids and their families know that the Lions are here, we care, and we're ready to support them on their journey.
